



Dear Harris Moran dealer and customer,

As your most trusted supplier of innovative seed products, we at Harris Moran want to keep you informed about the quality of our seed. One recent addition we have made to our packaging is to add a "Primed" sticker indicating the seed inside has been Primed.

If you see this Primed sticker on your seed package, it means a seed enhancement technology has been applied.

Do not apply any other seed enhancement or treating process to this seed including processes like hot water or chlorine treatment.

Additional treatments could damage the germination and vigor of the Primed lot and result in loss of stand, reduced yield, or crop failure. If you apply further seed enhancements or treatments, you void the warranty and accept full risk for any damage such as loss of germination or vigor.

One reminder: Like any other seed, primed seed must be retested six-months after the labeled germination test date. After six months, the Primed seed should be tested before each use. In ALL cases, testing should include a "stress test" to determine the overall quality of the Primed seed after storage.
